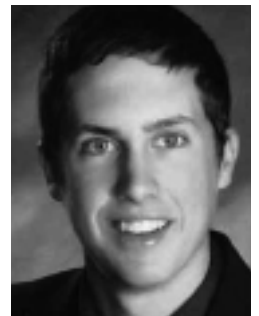

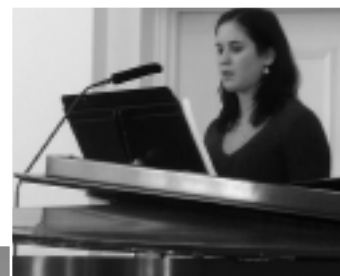
Brian Malik '11
