### Diocesan Directives for the Celebration of the Sacred Liturgy with Precautions for the Prevention of the H1N1 (Swine) Flu

The upcoming flu season, and additional health risk posed by outbreaks of H1N1 (swine) influenza, require timely directives for the celebration of the Sacred Liturgy and flu prevention.

1. The distribution of the Precious Blood for the faithful is generally suspended.
2. The exchange of the sign of peace is to be offered without any physical contact.
3. Use of holy water is suspended
