- Holy Week –
Holy Thursday – Amanda is getting people signed up for feet washing and contacting Public Safety for the procession flashlights and vests. Two people will also be needed to help during Mass to set up and remove chairs for feet washing. Eucharistic Adoration follows Mass at Newman House and will begin at approximately 9:30.
